

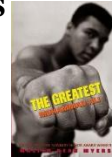
## Summer Book Report for Students Entering the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

### Report Directions

#### **Book annotations: (30 points)**



- Post its/sticky notes or write on the book pages throughout the book (NOT ONE ANNOTATION PER CHAPTER)
- Highlighted important information

#### **Content of book report: 5 paragraphs (50 points)**

- 1st paragraph- author, setting, time
- 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph- description of main characters
- 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph- plot (problem/ solution faced by characters)
- 4<sup>th</sup> paragraph- theme/ moral (underlying idea/ subject/ lesson learned)
- 5<sup>th</sup> paragraph- opinion/ recommendation

#### **Form (20 points)**

- Cover Page
- Typed (double spaced/ 12 font/ Times New Roman)

You may choose from one of the following books:

#### **Content of book report: 5 paragraphs (50 points)**

- 1st paragraph- author, setting, time
- 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph- description of main characters
- 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph- plot (problem/ solution faced by characters)
- 4<sup>th</sup> paragraph- theme/ moral (underlying idea/ subject/ lesson learned)
- 5<sup>th</sup> paragraph- opinion/ recommendation

#### **Book annotations: (30 points)**

- Highlight important information throughout the book
- Write your thoughts, important ideas, or pages summaries throughout the book. You can use post its/sticky notes or write on the actual book.

## **Summer Book Report for Students Entering the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade**

You may choose one of the following books:

- “The One and Only Ivan” by Katherine Applegate
- “The Big Friendly Giant” by Roald Dahl

### Report Directions

#### **Content of book report: 4 paragraphs (50 points)**

- 1st paragraph- author, setting, time
- 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph- short description of main characters
- 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph- plot (problem/ solution faced by characters)
- 4<sup>th</sup> paragraph- opinion/ recommendation

#### **Book Information: (30 points)**

- Highlight character’s names, settings, events and anything you find important throughout the book.
- You will write a short 1-2 sentence summary at the end of every chapter. You can use sticky note/post it’s or write directly on the book.

#### **Form (20 points)**

- Cover page
- Typed or write your paragraphs.
